Imex – hidden gem. Small company from Thailand that makes glass and through body porcelain, nice color range and quality.

Apavisa – expensive, but they took a different approach with the "bent tiles", check out the blue lights in the very back of the booth

Recer – Portuguese factory, expensive but nice looking product – Voltage, polished and a new twist on a "matte/polished" finish

Magma Art – Urban - cool 8x8 line that is "punched" with different sizes, the color palette is nice Urban Terra Cotta, Urban Cement, Urban White. Also, check out the "Gaudi Glass", very cool look in a tile to achieve the "cubed glass look"

Castlevetro – Naturae Aequa – the grey color is beautiful
